**INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION
FOR VENDOR'S LICENSE TO MAKE TAXABLE SALES**

- A. If taxable sales are made at more than one location in the county, a license application and a license are required for each location.
- B. In showing the name of the vendor, in the case of a partnership, show the names of all partners.
- C. If a new location is obtained, it will be necessary to obtain a new license. **The license issued will permit sales only at the location specified on the face of the license.**
- D. State the kind of business in which the vendor is engaged. For example, if engaged in the floral business, state "floral business." If operating a bookstore, show "bookstore." If the vendor is engaged in several lines of business, any one of which might deserve a separate classification, the applicant should state on the license that type of business from which he receives the largest part of his gross sales. In other words, if the applicant operates a furniture store and, at the same location, sells radios and household appliances, the question would arise as to which kind of business would be shown in answer to this question. **It is imperative that only one kind of business be shown in answer to this,** and therefore, if the applicant decided that he sold more furniture than he did radios and household appliances, he would indicate "furniture store" in answer to the question.
- E. If the vendor has a liquor permit, the name and address of the vendor's license must be exactly the same as shown on the liquor permit.
